SEMINAR DESCRIPTION:

EMDR Therapy can fail to make significant progress in the presence of ego states or alters that are hostile to the process, frightened of it, or whose needs are not being met in therapy. Ego states exist along a continuum from normal, healthy adaptation through PTSD, Complex PTSD to Dissociative Identity Disorder. Client and therapist alike are often not aware of the presence of these ego states +/- alters that prevent effective treatment and make life so challenging.

Through this intensive, small group seminar, you will: DEVELOP a sophisticated understanding of dissociative processes with clients with severe traumas. Even PTSD symptoms are dissociative in nature; PRACTICE in supervised triads two different techniques – the Conference Room and the Healing Circle – for integrating Ego State Therapy and Structural Dissociation into your work with clients; INTEGRATE Ego State and EMDR therapies into immediate work with healthier clients to develop the skills needed to use them with your more challenged clients; UNDERSTAND the dissociative language of severely traumatized clients;
